If your concerns are serious or urgent, child protection referrals must be made by telephone to Children's Services (CERMT) 0161 217 6028, and followed up within 24 hours within a written report on the Common Assessment Form. The Common Assessment form is available on the website below.

The Named Nurse for Safeguarding Children should be informed when a child protection referral is being made. In child protection cases, parental consent is not required, but parents should be informed unless doing so would put the child at increased risk.
